***Hazmat Management Plan***

Contractor must remove all lamps and ballasts from the lighting fixtures. The contractor will then place them in the packaging provided by ALR:

- 4' & 8' Boxes or Fiber drums for packaging fluorescent lamps
- 55 Gallon Steel drums for packaging lighting ballasts

Contractor will sort PCB Ballasts & Non-PCB Ballasts into separate drums provided. The drums will have the following labels, which are provided by ALR:

- Non-PCB Lighting Ballasts for Recycling
- RQ, Polychlorinated Biphenyls Mixture, 9, UN2315, PG III

Lamp containers will have the following label, which is provided by ALR:

- Universal Waste Lamps for Recycling

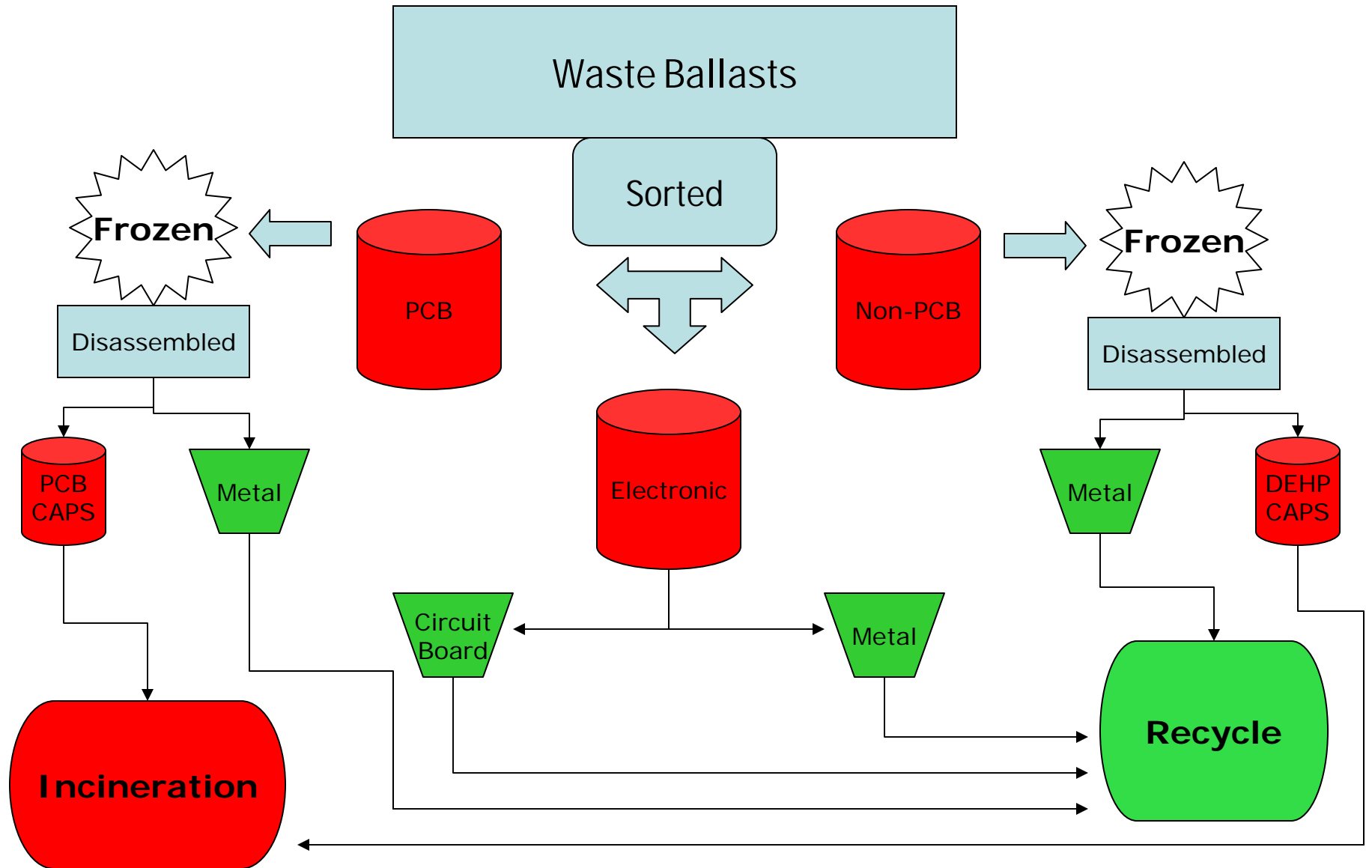
Contractor will fill in Accumulation Start Date on the labels with the date when materials are 1<sup>st</sup> put into each container. Materials will be stored on-site until the scheduled pick-up.

ALR will pick-up the Universal Waste on our company truck from the customer location using a Non-Haz Manifest for transportation documentation. Our truck is fully permitted & insured to transport these materials. The materials will be brought back to our facility at:
